Admission Requirements

Admission to CATUC is open to students of every faith and background. The following are the general requirements for our undergraduate, graduate, and doctoral programmes. Programme-specific entry criteria are listed in the Revised Admission Guidelines available from the Office of the Registrar.

HND

- ◆ A pass in GCE Ordinary Level (≥4 subjects) or Probatoire
- ◆ Subject combinations relevant to the chosen HND programme
- ◆ Photocopy of birth certificate
- ◆ Photocopies of O/L certificates or slips
- ◆ Registration receipt of 15,000 CFAF
- ◆ Passport photograph (1,000 CFAF, taken on campus)

Undergraduate

- ◆ A pass in GCE Ordinary Level or Probatoire
- ◆ A pass in at least two GCE Advanced Level subjects (excluding Religious Studies) or BAC
- ◆ A pass in English at GCE O/L or proof of proficiency from an accredited centre
- ◆ Photocopy of birth certificate
- ◆ Photocopies of O/L and A/L certificates or slips
- ◆ Registration receipt of 15,000 CFAF
- ◆ Passport photograph (1,000 CFAF, taken on campus)

Graduate (Master's)

- ◆ Bachelor's degree from CATUC or another recognised university
- ◆ Minimum GPA of 2.0 / 4.0 (lower GPA may be considered with relevant work experience)
- ◆ Certified photocopies of degree certificate, attestation, and transcripts
- ◆ Curriculum Vitae
- ◆ Two recommendation letters (one academic, one professional)
- ◆ Registration receipt of 20,000 CFAF
- ◆ Passport photograph (1,000 CFAF)

Doctoral (PhD)

- ◆ Master's degree from a recognised university
- ◆ Minimum GPA of 3.00 / 4.00
- ◆ Programme-specific subject background
- ◆ Certified academic transcripts and degree certificate
- ◆ Curriculum Vitae and statement of research interest
- ◆ Two academic recommendation letters
- ◆ Registration and processing fees as set by the Registrar

Holders of foreign certificates must obtain an equivalence via the MINESUP portal at www.equivalence.cm. Applicants to MSc programmes in STANR and to Philosophy (under-graduate and postgraduate) must certify all certificates and slips.
